She mentioned that efforts to promote the country as a safe tourism destination will be continued and this will also be applied to the international market. "For a start, we want this (safe travel) to be proven in the domestic tourism industry which we should all work together to revive."

"Those activities need to be carried out with utmost responsibility while practicing the new normal and strictly adhering to all standard operating procedures (SOPs) set by the National Security Council (NSC) and the Ministry of Health (MoH). Even though the Visit Malaysia 2020 campaign has been cancelled, efforts to promote the country as a safe destination for tourists will continue," she said.

More Dolphins and Turtles Return to Port Dickson

更多海豚海龟重返波德申海域



The absence of all form of recreational or irresponsible commercial fishing activities, as well as other human activities throughout the entire MCO and CMCO is said to be the main factors that lead to the return of more dolphins spotted swimming closer to the shores of Tanjung Tuan beaches in Port Dickson. Bopping in and out of the calm sea surface of the Port Dickson's waters in pods, these magnificent creatures are actually considered quite a regular sight to the local fisherman or the Department of Fisheries (DOF) as they often appear even on any other regular days, and are not disturbed as they belong to a protected species.



Over 200 turtle eggs have also been discovered along popular tourist beaches in Port Dickson during the CMCO, half of them belong to Green turtles while the remaining are from unknown species. Turtles have always been known to land on Port Dickson beaches to lay their eggs, though scarce and never in such large quantity. This is also largely attributed to human activities and light pollution. These turtle eggs have been transferred over to the local marine conservation centres to be incubated.

Malaysia Sets Stage for Domestic Tourism Recovery

大马为国内旅游业复苏万事俱备

随着马来西亚政府正式公布将开始实行复苏式行动管制令（RMCO）并重新允许跨州行动，马来西亚的酒店和旅游业公司也准备好再次迎国内游客。

From June 10 to August 31, the RMCO replaces the country's Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO), and will see the easing of interstate travel, as well as meetings and workshops, under strict health protocols. However, the country's borders will remain shut.

Making the announcement in a televised broadcast Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, said the RMCO will feature more lenient restrictions and formed part of the country's exit strategy.

Malaysian Association of Hotels (MAH) CEO, Yap Lip Seng, said that the move is significant for the tourism industry as it marks the beginning of the resumption of domestic travel, which will pave the way to industry recovery.

He added that tourism stakeholders had long prepared for this day to come, particularly the hotel industry with its very own guidelines to ensure a clean and safe stay for tourists and guests alike.

On May 1, MAH published its base guidelines for hotels, designed to steer hotels into the new norm of hotel operations in the post-COVID era, benchmarked against Ministry of Health's requirements and best practices from other countries and major hotel chains around the world.

Entering the RMCO, Yap said the industry is expecting a pickup in not only leisure travel but also business travellers. Although hotels generally are investing and spending more in compliance to SOPs, many are rolling back room rates, offering attractive packages and promotions for direct bookings on their websites, according to Yap.
